



The \$23 Planter Box



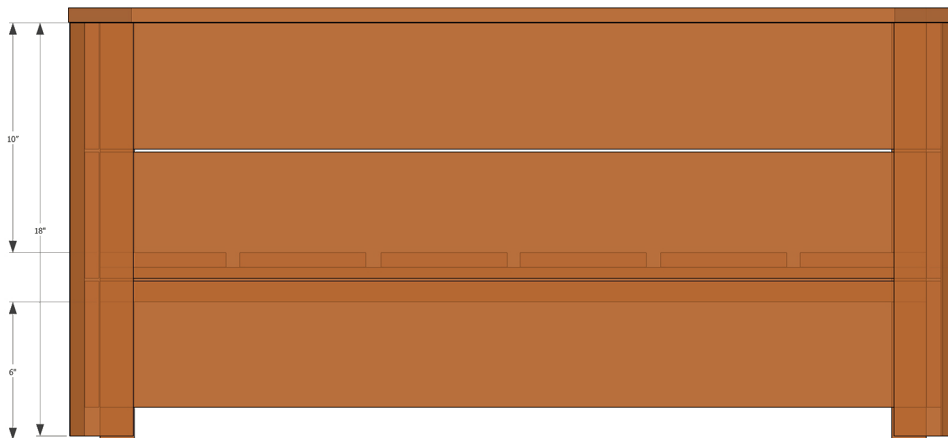
This planter box requires 9 Cedar pickets measuring 5 1/2" W x 6' H x 5/8" D. It also requires one 8' 2x4.

Cut the 2x4 in half length wise, leaving you with 2 2x2s. Cut the 2x2s as follows:

36" (2), 13" (2), 10" (4), 6" (4)

Cut the pickets as follows:

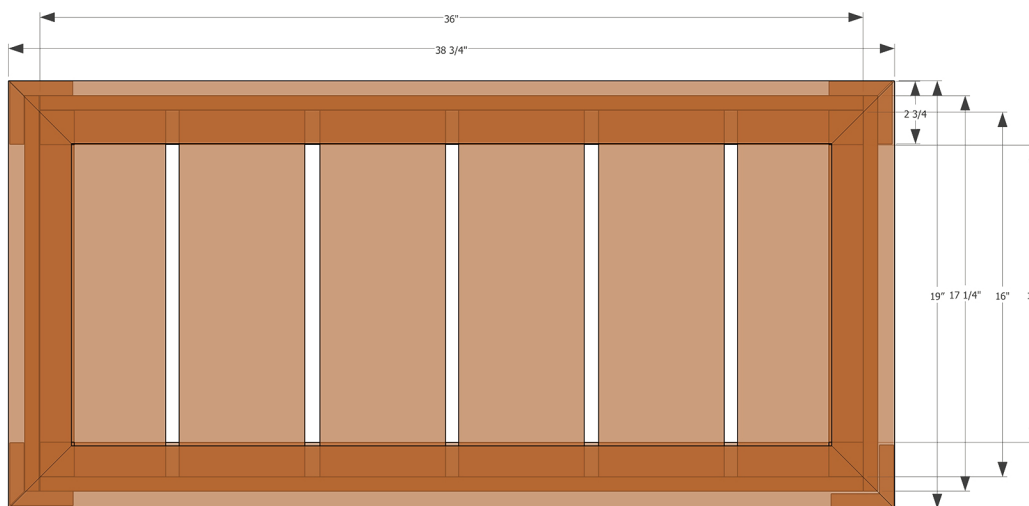
36" (6) - Long siding
17 1/4" (6) - Short siding
16 1/4" (6) - Floor boards



Cut the pickets in half lengthwise and at a 45° angle for the corner pieces.

18" (8)

Lastly, cut one picket in half lengthwise, creating two lengths of 2 3/4" width. Create a picture frame for the top of the box - typically with two sides measuring 38 3/4" and two measuring 19 1/2".



Assemble using brad nails, 3" wood screws and 1 1/2" wood screws. Water seal if necessary.
