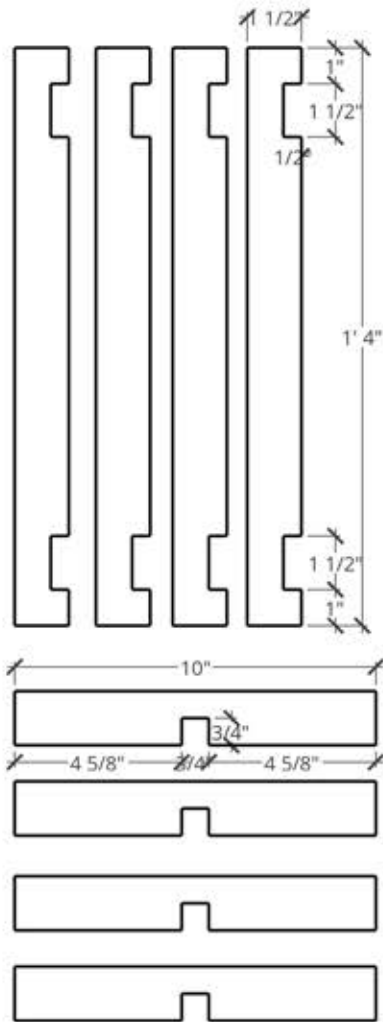


MID-CENTURY MODERN PLANT STAND

FOR HEAVIER PLANTS

Adjust these lengths to accommodate larger plant pots



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1)** Start with 1" x 2" boards (they typically measure 3/4" x 1 1/2") and cut them into 4 legs measuring 16" each, and then 3 crossbars measuring 10" each.
- 2)** Set your circular saw to a depth of 1/2" and notch out the 1 1/2" wide gaps at the top and bottom of each leg. It's easiest to do this to all four legs at the same time. You can tape them together to make it easier.
- 3)** Set your circular saw to a depth of 3/4" and make the center notches in the crossbars. They need to be 3/4" wide.
- 4)** If necessary, use a chisel to clean up the notches.
- 5)** Apply wood glue to the notches and push all pieces together. Use clamps to hold the pieces together until dry. Spray with lacquer to finish.
