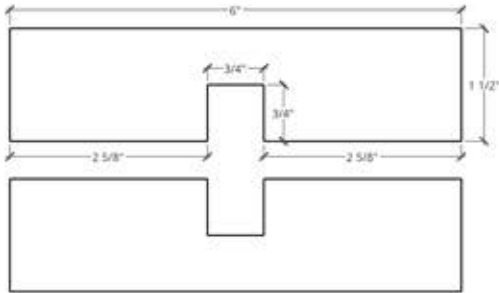


MID-CENTURY MODERN PLANT STAND

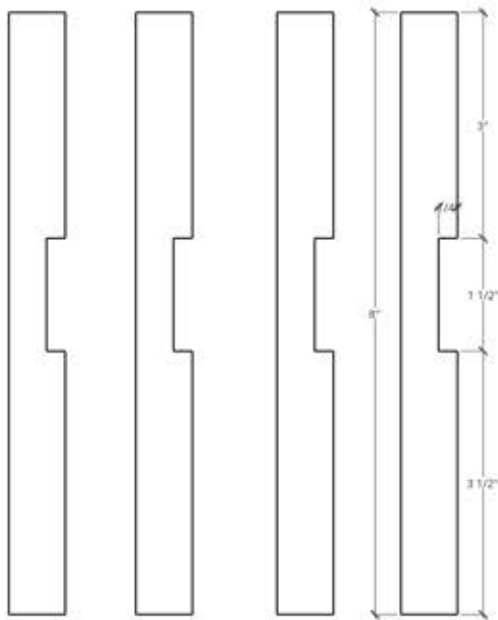

Adjust these lengths to accommodate larger plant pots



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1)** Cut 16" of a 1" x 2" board (actual measurement: 3/4" x 1 1/2") in half length-wise. Then cut those into 8" lengths, giving you four legs. Proceed to cut 4 lengths of 6" from the full 1.5" board.
- 2)** Set your circular saw to a depth of 1/4" and notch out the 1 1/2" wide gaps from each leg. It's easiest to do this to all four legs at the same time. You can tape them together to make it easier.
- 3)** Set your circular saw to a depth of 3/4" and make the center notches in the crossbars. They need to be 3/4" wide.
- 4)** If necessary, use a chisel to clean up the notches.
- 5)** Apply wood glue to the notches and push all pieces together. Use clamps to hold the pieces together until dry. Spray with lacquer to finish.
